Johnathan 'Fatal1ty' Wendel is attending GamesCom.

The eSport legend will give several interviews, stage performances and autographs every day.

Munich/Cologne, August 19th 2009 – The best-known cyber-athlete Johnathan Wendel, also known as 'Fatal1ty', will be attending GamesCom in Cologne August 20th to 23rd. During his stay he will participate with the Intel Tech Talks and give interviews. He will also sign autographs and stand by for photos with his fans. During the entire trade fair, the Game-TV.com camera crew will follow him for coverage about the eSport icon which will be published in September.

Johnathan 'Fatal1ty' Wendel became famous for his successes and awards in several FPS games such as Quake 3. Last week, he received a very special medal: On August 13th he was given the honor to be the first inductee to the Video Game Hall of Fame in Ottumwa, Iowa. He was recognized for his "outstanding achievements in gaming". Johnathan 'Fatal1ty' Wendel is the first gamer who is the world champion in five different disciplines, winning a total of 12 titles.

In April this year, he proved why he is still a feared enemy: During the CEC Copenhagen Conference he set a Guinness World Record for most frags within an hour. He scored 672 frags in only 60 Minutes against five rotating competitors.

Johnathan "Fatal1ty" Wendel became the world's first full time professional video gamer in 1999 and since then has dominated competitions all over the world, winning an unprecedented 12 world titles in 5 different games. His dedication to the concept of competitive video gaming led him to create a range of gaming gear that carries the Fatal1ty Brand. Additionally at the Copenhagen eSport Challenge Johnathan "Fatal1ty" Wendel achieved the Guinness world record through playing Quake death match-IV with five rotating opponents and gaining 672 frags in 1 hour. In honor of his contributions, Johnathan was awarded the first ever Lifetime Achievement Award in the four-year history of the eSports-Award for "showing exceptional sportsmanship, taking part in shaping eSports into what it is today and for being the prime representative of this young sport. He has become the figurehead for eSports worldwide."
